#### Anniversary Weekend Celebrations - Please share with Members

The Anniversary Weekend Celebrations Are always held in September of each year. The Celebrations are located in different parts of the country so that all members have the opportunity to take part. Details are always sent to **ALL members individually** along with the Minutes of the July Executive meeting of that year. This is the meeting where ALL members can exercise their right to vote upon often important matters affecting every AUHS member; as well as supporting the future growth and development of AUHS.

It is at this time that ALL members also have the opportunity to "nominate" themselves or another well respected AUHS member for any of the posts held within AUHS. The volunteer work of all our members and Affiliated Churches is vital to the continuance and strength of AUHS.

Positions Available to Apply for from Sept. Vice President (south) 2 year posted chosen by interview not vote; responsible for all UK south of line drawn from the Mersey to the Humber right down to Cornwall and Kent etc. (ideally he/she should live Mersey/Humber area but not necessarily so), Vice President (north) 2 year posted by interview not vote, National Secretary 1 year, Membership Secretary 1 year, Treasurer 1 year, Healer Representative 1 year elected at healer's meeting, Senior Officer elected at Minister's meeting, Newsletter Editor 1 year (2 issues per year), Senior Minister 1 year; Minutes Taker 1 year, Webmaster 1 year (Post requirements: accuracy in all aspects including Grammar and Spelling; all web changes subject to prior approval by Executives), Publications Officer 1 year. Certificates Printer.

### Important Members Rights
